

PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

The controller of your personal data is:

Akademie klasické hudby, z. ú., with registered office Malostranské nám. 37/23, 118 00 Prague 1, Malá Strana, Company ID No.: 26725347, registered with the Municipal Court of Prague, section: C, folio 527.

The controller processes personal data in accordance with Act No. 110/2019 Coll., on processing personal data, as amended, and Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (general data protection regulation, or "GDPR")

Personal data to be processed:

- title, first and last name, date of birth, address of residence, email address, telephone, data stated in the curriculum vitae and in detailed justification (i.e. data included in nomination forms and their annexes), as well as photography, sound and image recordings procured at rehearsals and concerts of Orchestrální akademie ("Orchestral Academy") in Kroměříž and in Prague.

The purpose of processing the personal data is:

- recording registrations, their processing, informing of the progress of evaluating registrations, decisions on acceptance, and other actions oriented toward participation in the Orchestral Academy during Letní hudební akademii Kroměříž ("Kroměříž Summer Music Academy") and subsequent participation in the graduate concert on 13 September 2020 entitled Mladá filharmonie Dvořákovy Prahy ("Dvořák Prague Young Philharmonic") as part of the Dvořákova Praha International Music Festival.
- Promotional activities of the controller and co-organizer for the event, Collegium musicale z. s.

Recipients of personal data:

- Akademie klasické hudby, z. ú.
- Co-organizer of the event Collegium musicale z. s.
- Instructors of the Orchestral Academy
- The public (data may be published on web pages, in the annual report, on the posters and printed materials of the Controller or co-organizers, and other media).

The registrant declares that if they have provided the Controller with the personal data of third parties in connection with their registration with the Orchestral Academy during the Kroměříž Summer Music Academy, they have obtained from these third parties explicit consent to the provision of their personal data to the Controller and to the subsequent processing of their personal data by the Controller for the above purposes.

You have the right to raise an objection to the processing of personal data for the above purpose on the part of the Academy of Classical Music. In such cases we will no longer process your personal data.

Your rights associated with the processing of personal data including the right to lodge an objection may be exercised at the email address info@akademieklasickehudby.cz.

The Controller hereby in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter "**Regulation**") declares that:

- the personal data of Data Subjects will be processed on the basis of their willing consent, under the conditions stated above.
- the reason for provision of the personal data of the Data Subject is the interest of the Data Subject in participating in the Orchestral Academy during the Kroměříž Summer Music Festival for the year 2020, which is organized by the Controller and Collegium musicale z. s., which would not be possible without providing this data,
- no automated decision-making or profiling takes place when processing the personal data of the Data Subject,
- the Controller does not intend to provide the personal data of the Data Subject to any third country, international organization, or to any party other than the recipients,
- The Data Subject has the right at any time to revoke their consent to the processing of the personal data (revocation of consent shall not affect the legality of processing based on the consent given prior to its revocation), the right to request from the Controller access to their personal data, its erasure or modification, or the restriction of processing, and has the right to portability of this data to another controller. The rights stated above are limited by the legal obligations of the Controller when processing personal data. Any revocation of consent must be enacted in a documented format, ideally in writing, sent to the controller or those responsible for the processing of personal data appointed by the Controller.
- The Data Subject has the right to file a complaint with the Office of Personal Data Protection if the Controller has acted in breach of the law when processing personal data.
- The sender of the Registration provides consent to the Organizer under this paragraph for a period of five (5) years.
